SJC Academic Honour Roll 2023

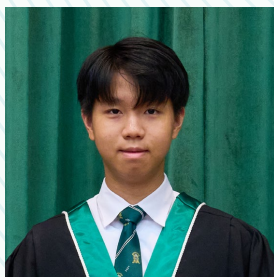
